Planetary movements from New Moon Feb 11 to New Moon Mar 13, 2021

The **Sun**, **Mercury**, **Venus**, **Jupiter and Saturn** are integrating the radical change agent energy of **Aquarius**. **Mars** moves from **Taurus** into **Gemini** telling us perhaps that "Fun is better than Perfect"! **Saturn squaring Uranus** makes us question the structure of reality we think we know.
