**Venus** is highest and brightest in the a.m. sky for the next 51 days **Venus** is in a 10 degree orb to **Mars** 

**Jupiter** is not visible after 2/19 **Saturn** becomes visible in morning sky around 2/16

### **Feb 11-16** —according to EarthSky

40 minutes before sunrise rise we can see **Venus**, **Mars** and **Mercury** in the eastern sky above where the sun will rise.

**February 16th and March 5: Two exact conjunctions of Mars and Venus.** The morning star apparition of Venus and Mars within 10 degrees is part of Rapunzel/Dumuzi saga when the mythology says the prince and Rapunzel meet after their time apart.

On Feb 27, The Astroid, Vesta will be there as well, unseen, between Venus and Mars as will the waning crescent moon.

**Mercury** moves from the air sign overtone, Libra, to the earth sign overtone, Capricorn when Mercury goes direct.

Feb 2, Wed: Imbolc called St Brighid's Day and later called,

notice the urge to renew—This is a seed point in both our inner
and outer realm. Traditions include fasting, spring cleaning—
removing the old in preparation for a new astrological year at the
Spring Equinox.

**Imbolc means "**in the belly" and is associated with ewes' lactation that begins in order to nourish their babes during this lambing time.

The original festival was associated with the goddess 'Brigid', a daughter of the Dagda, or sun god, Lugh. This Celtic Fire Goddess, Brighid, brings healing, purification, renewal, fertility, and creativity at Imbolc. St Bridget is often referred to as 'Mary of the Gael' —Daniel relates this to Spica. This Full moon, 5000 years ago, would have been conjunct Spica, the star that represents the most radiant expansion of the feminine. Candlemas was the name given to Imbolc when Christian tradition overlaid pagan days of celebration and gave a new name and meaning to them. The church's ceremonial candles for the year were created at Imbolc.
