## Beltane

The name "Beltane" is derived from the word "Beltene" from old Irish, meaning "bright fire". Beltane is thought to be directly related to the Celtic god Belenus, a deity comparable to Apollo and to Baldr in Germanic mythology. This luminous god's name means "bright". He is known for healing, medicine and the arts.

Home lights are extinguished on the eve of Beltane and relit from the festive Beltane bonfire embers that languish into Beltane morn.
