

**Silvianne:** When the sun is conjunct retrograde Mercury on January 23rd it is at 03 Aquarius 22, even though it is about to enter Capricorn

**Daniel:** This is a great illustration of how Aquarius is attempting to have some kind of an influence on transforming the entrenchments of old Capricorn

**Greg:** the Sun and Pluto conjunct pondering..

**Daniel:** If we are looking at the initiatory window of something like a Pluto return or Pluto conjunction we use the 1 degree prior to begin this.

January 19, 2022 to October 11, 2023 is the date range of the Pluto return

Pluto will actually go all the way up to the natal degree of the US Pluto so we start the initiatory range one degree before that which is where the Jan 19, 2022 comes in. Pluto makes its first exact hit in February 2022 on the US Natal Pluto. We Use the longer range for an individual chart—it will go up to 2023.

**Sao:** Shows the astrology chart for today, January 2 at 10am: All planets and asteroids are to the left of the north and south nodes—between the north and south nodes. The entire right half of the chart is empty except for the descendant. It is like half the sky is filled and half is empty. It brings to mind the Nicholas Kristof book, WOMEN HOLD UP HALF THE SKY. The moon will be there for a few days.

**Daniel:** The moon will be there until the moon goes up to the end of Taurus

**Sao:** With all the planets and asteroids between the nodes, not only is it half the sky, but it is right in-between the nodes. That has to be significant

**Mary:** it is an in-between time for sure.

**Greg:** In Vedic astrology, I believe they call it “Kali Sarpa Yoga”, or something like that. It is a phenomenon that the Vedic Astrologers do consider. I am not an expert on it but I do believe when everything is encapsulated by the nodes—other than the moon—it happened in 2020 and it happened in 2021. I was conversing with a friend of mine in Belgium and she was suggesting it was a signature of Covid. So I went back from the time when I was born in the 60’s—there is no way to do a search with solar fire—so I was just manually clicking through. It is not a regular thing. It is this idea of having consciousness bound between the head and tail of the dragon. I am not an expert on it and only started looking into it because of this signature that you have identified right here the came to my awareness a few days ago.

**Daniel:** It reminds me first of all, the it wasn’t until 2007, 2008, at least in my orbit, that anyone was noticing the rarity of all planets direct. This seems to be even more unique. You are the great research Mavin there, Greg. See if you can find out more about what your friends say about it. It would certainly be within the privy of those that follow Vedic Astrology because they are about the only other school of astrology really that has much emphasis on then nodes- (though different than us). They actually see the North and South Nodes as planets, practically. So let’s follow up on this. Sao, this is a phenomenal thing to bring up. I appreciate this a lot.

**Sao:** It so happens that this time around, Jupiter is at the exact midpoint of this.

**Daniel:** Let’s keep track of this and notice if there is anything noticeable when the moon does enter into Gemini to see if there is a shift of any kind of energy at that point.

**Greg:** I think if you take the moon out of it, the alignment stays that way until April. We can look at it not just when the Moon moves into Gemini, because that will be in couple days, we could look at it over the next few months.

**Daniel:** That corresponds also to the amount of time the planets are all direct.

**Greg:** It brings us to eclipse season as well which Awen writes is the 27th (April). The eclipse is April 30th—just a week later. It will be interesting to watch.

**Sao:** And also it was happening yesterday on the Gregorian New Year.

**Mary:** What comes to mind for me is the south node is our past, the patriarchal heritage that we have all come from. The north node is the intent where we are going to and we are hanging between those two things right now. We are at a really culminating point of letting go of the past and being able to step into the future and after the next new moon when we have all these planets direct it will be full steam ahead to take us there. The last time we had that was when the whole Covid story opened up. It may be another chapter of the Covid story that helps, unfortunately, to take us....

**Daniel:** the other factor though is if the North Node is moving us toward.. always look at the north node as where collective humanity is moving towards. If we just did not use when the moon reaches 01 Gemini, and the fact that nothing else goes up to the north node, that to me is like so much is in the balance for these next three or four months. When everything is in direct motion, the good thing about that is that everything is in plane sight. Everything will be revealed.

**Sao:** one other thing we may want to watch about this is when the nodes go into Scorpio and Taurus this will still be in place. And that is why I am thinking perhaps we are going from this long stretch with the nodes in Sag and Gemini having to be about the truth about duality and then they shift to Taurus Scorpio and the truth about duality is “Women hold up half the sky!”

**Daniel:** Ha, ha—that is beautiful and of course what we see as the sign meanings of Taurus and Scorpio is they are both on the feminine side (Earth and Water) archetypically of the script.

**Silvianne:** to me everything has meaning-it has significance. Because the planets are all on the left side of the chart it is about going from the south node to the north node—to our destiny.

**Daniel:** This feels like the flavor of an esoteric council meeting. This has opened the door. We have here forward thinkers and out-of-the box thinker to come up with this stuff.
